Twenty-seven staff from various departments at Echuca Regional Health will be recognised for their academic achievements with Graduation Ceremonies this. The staff have spent the past year, undertaking the nationally recognised Certificates with The University of Ballarat as part of the Federal Government Traineeship Program.

The funding made available for this training program has enabled ERH to implement education courses for staff in a number of areas including Hospitality, Client/Patient Support and Frontline Management. The courses were designed to formally recognise the current skills of staff, in addition to providing up-to-date training to ensure quality service.

John Carey, Education Manager for Echuca Regional Health, stated “It is great to see the staff getting to the end of their courses. Many of the people involved have not studied for a number of years.”
